



- Tax Reform: For a fairer, more accountable, and modernized tax system
- Tax Relief:
 - Sales tax reduction to .6%.
 - Double and triple digit percentage reductions in business property classifications.
 - Across the board Income tax reductions of .5%.
 - Additional License Tabs reduction.
 - Rebate.
- Telecommunications Reform: Same reform package as last year.
To promote competition by allowing telephone companies to compete on a level playing field.
- Education Reform: Reform the way we pay teachers. Limit new spending.
- Workforce Development: Merge Department of Trade and Economic Development and Department of Economic Security. This recognizes that workforce development and economic security go hand in hand.
- Single Session: Reform the way the legislature works. Challenge the Legislature to make the process more accountable.
Will also encourage more candidates to serve.
- Campaign Finance Reform: Close the soft money loophole.

Many will misrepresent our reforms as tax increases. But the fact is this is a reform and relief agenda. In the end the people will have more money in their pockets and the state less in theirs.
